The name Gnoo Blas was taken from the original map of the district prepared by explorer Major Thomas Mitchell who adopted it from the Wiradjuri word meaning "two shoulders"





The Track

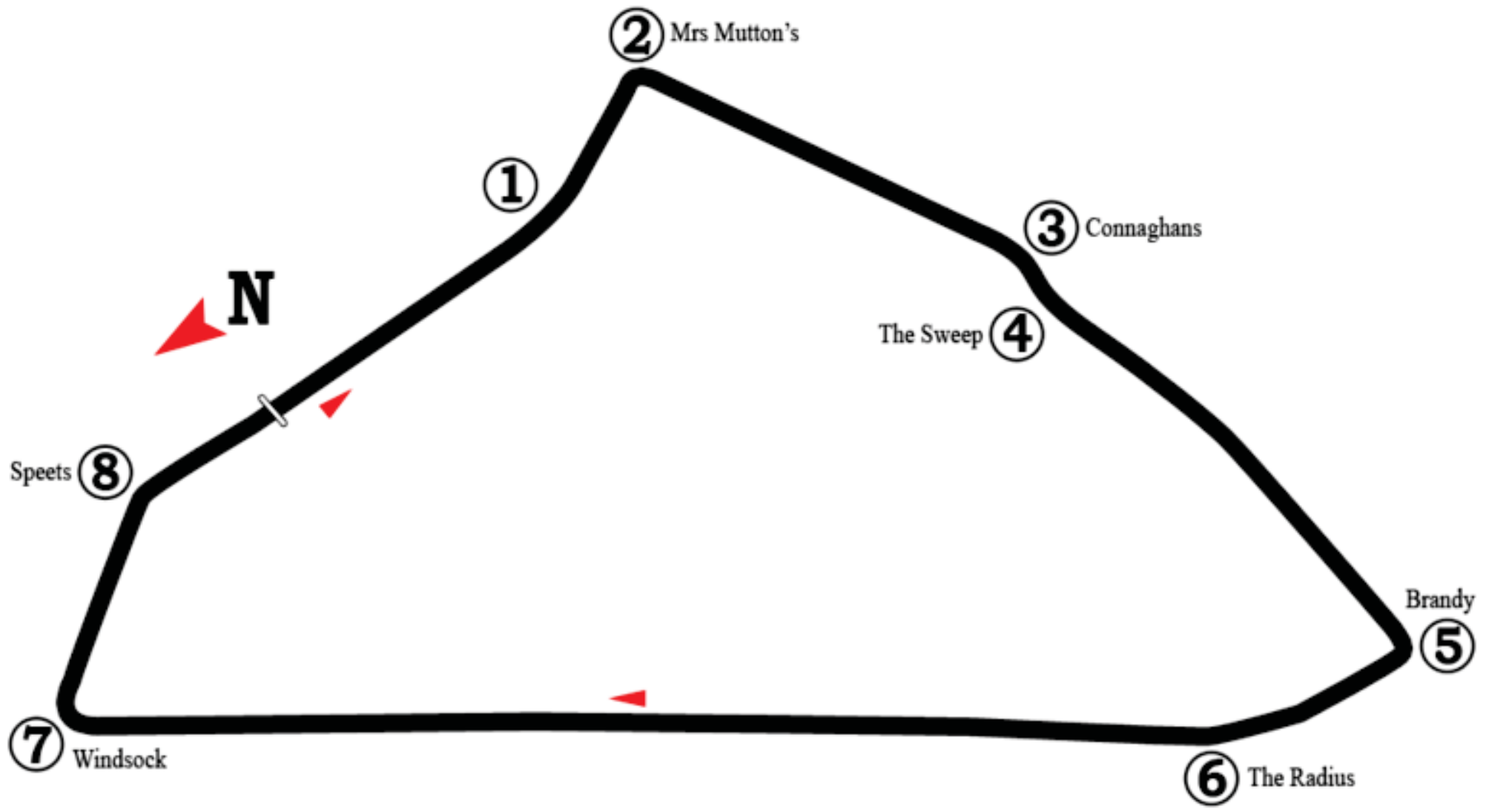
The circuit was open in Jan 1953

The lap record is held by Jon Leighton driving a Cooper Climax in Oct 1960 av speed 105.2mph (178.1kph)

The first Touring Car round

In January 1960, the first Australian Touring Car Championship (now the V8s) was run at Gnoo Blas along with the first race for the new class for Grand Touring cars.

David McKay won from Bill Pitt and Ron Hodgson, all in Jaguars, in an action-packed race.

McKay recorded 132.7mph on the long straight.



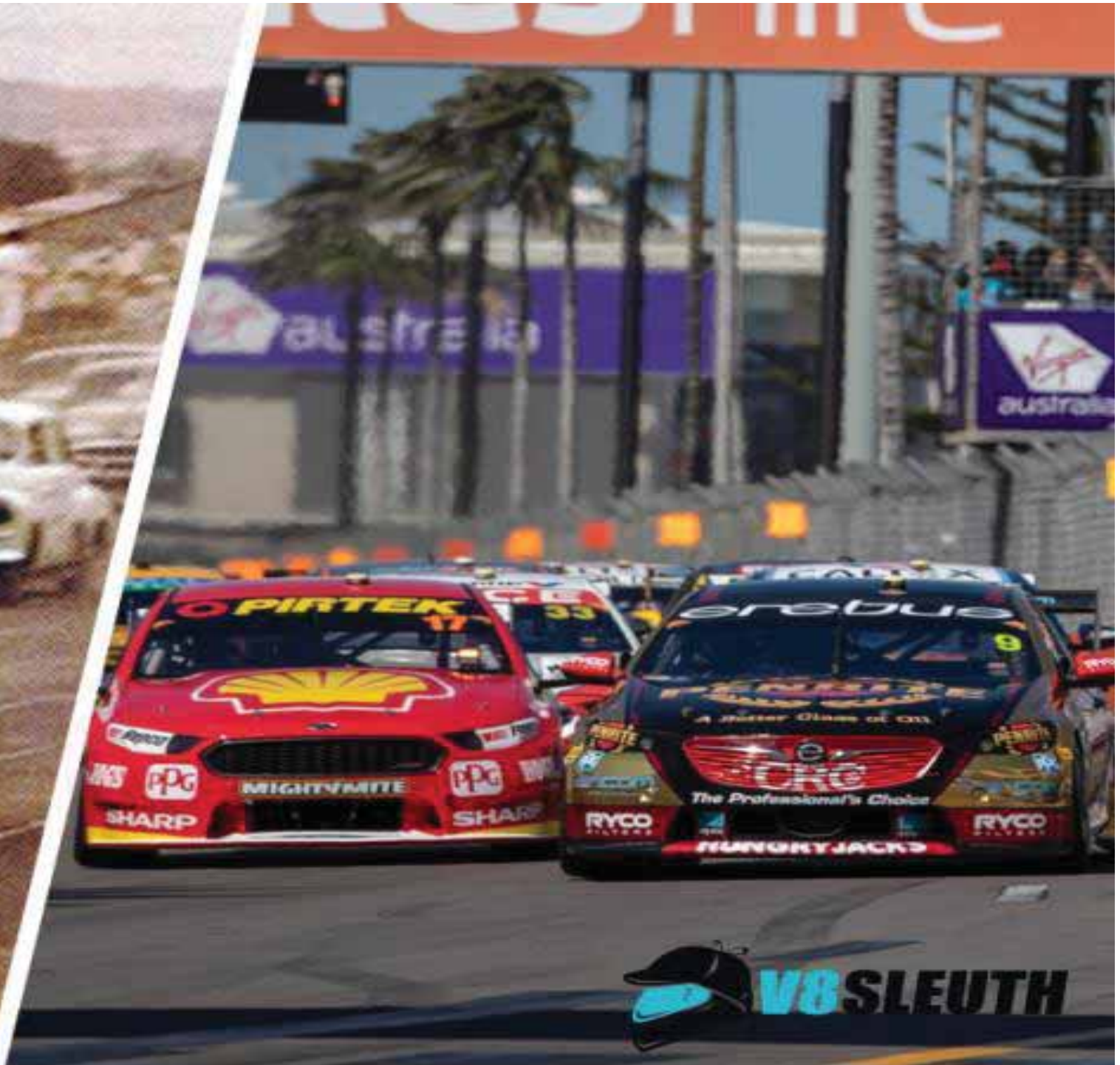
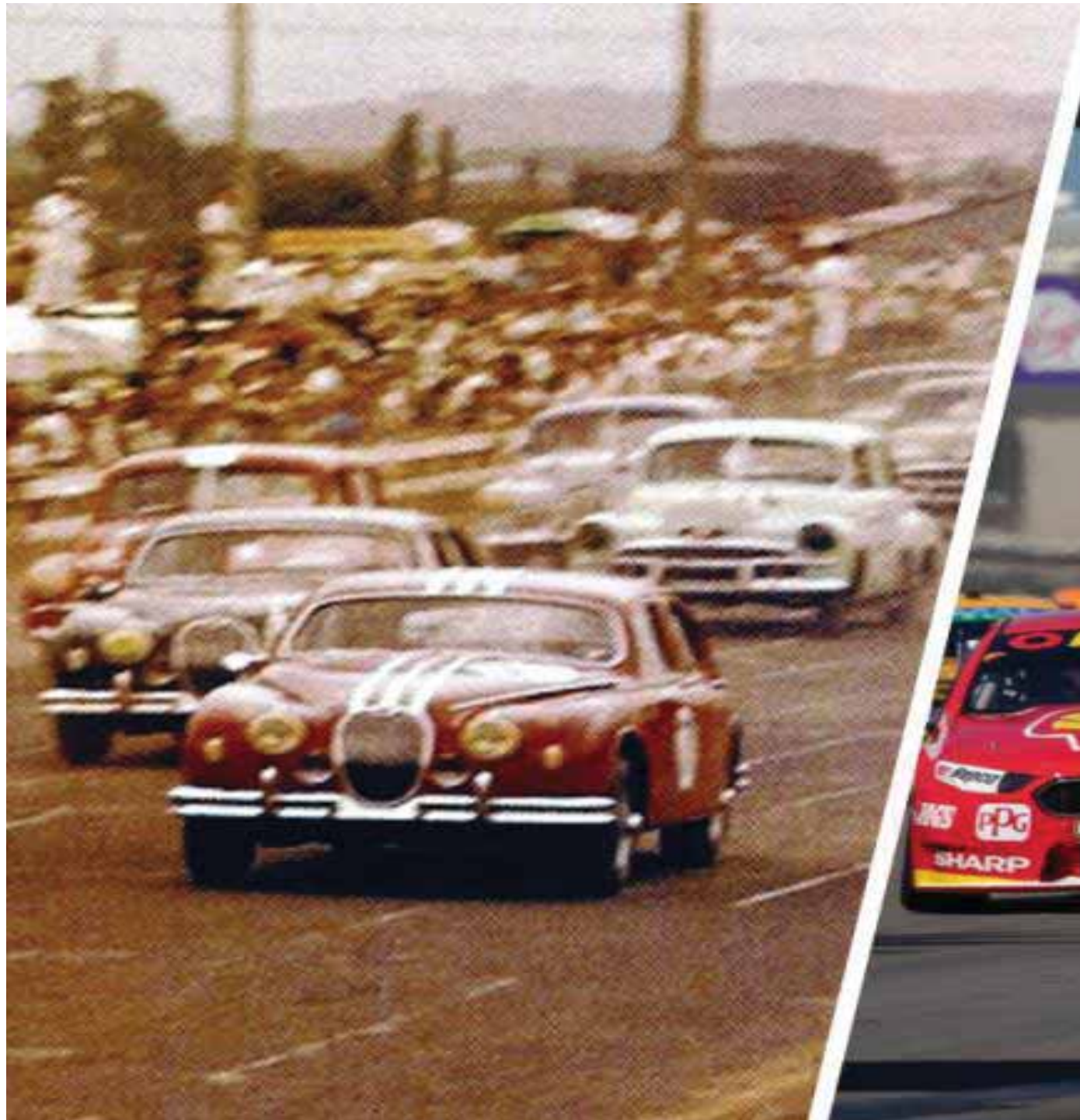

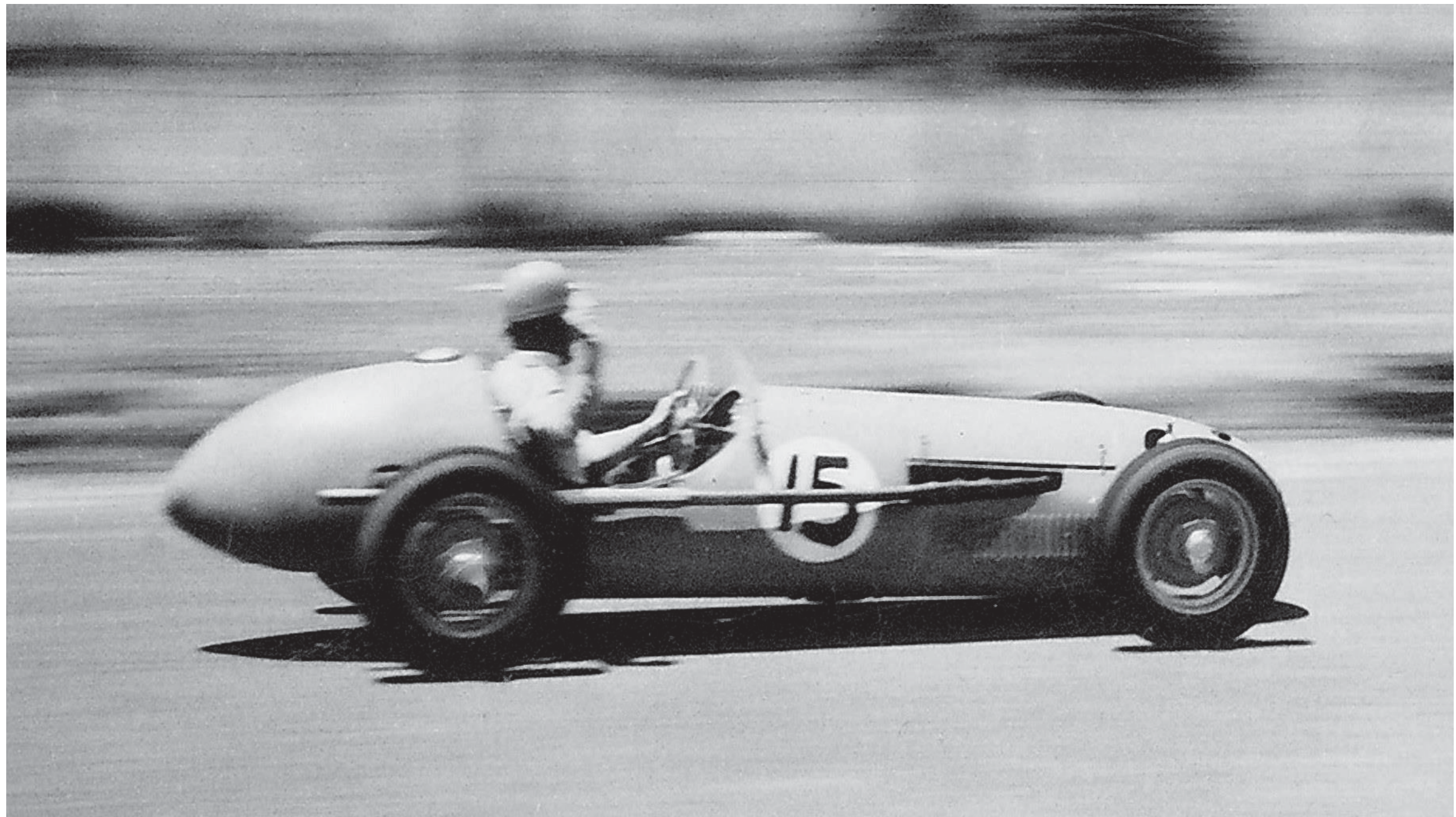
